Darling wee Eve was a very special in-patient at the EHF Animal Clinic in Rarotonga for around two weeks over the festive season. Eve came into our care on New Years eve (hence her name). She was found wandering around the local Pununganui Market alone, hungry, scared and very cautious of humans. In fact, we couldn't touch for quite a few days without her wincing or cowering on the ground . Unfortunately, abandonment occurs frequently in the islands leaving many puppies to survive on their own. We are grateful that Eve came into our care, and that a kind donor like Michelle assisted us with the expensive spay operation required to ensure Eve doesn't have any puppies in the future and we can stop the cycle of unwanted and homeless puppies in the Cook Islands.

After just a few days with us, Eve was showing signs of becoming an adventurous happy little canine and displayed a lot more confidence and trust in humans. This process did require some focused TLC from the Esther Honey staff , but we got there.

Eve stayed with us at the clinic for a couple of weeks as we fed her, loved her and our resident Vet completed her spay operation - little Eve was finally ready for adoption.

A family soon came in and adopted Eve (a really lovely family with two children and a large garden up in the hills of Rarotonga) and we feel confident she will be happy in her new "forever" home.
